

On Tuesday we will be discussing our selection for the MCPF Print/dpi Championships. Below are outlined the rules for the competitions and some indications as to how we respond to the challenge. Last year we were the best performing Small club in the Midlands Counties for prints for the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in 4 years. I would like us to make our best effort to retain that title. So if you haven't sent me images yet please bring 5 (FIVE only) on a stick along with any prints you wish to be considered for use in our portfolio.

### General Rules

- Only images new to the Championships may be used.
- The Print and dpi sections are separate competitions so the same images can be used in both.
- Each club will enter 15 images in each section entered.
- No more than 3 images can be used from any one author.
- No more than 4 nature images may be used.
- Clubs finishing in the first 8 positions will proceed to the second round where they will enter 10 images which must include at least 5 new images and cannot include more than 2 images from any one author.

What this means to us?

- We will need 5 images from a minimum of 5 members but in reality we need images from nearer 8 or more people. This means a minimum of 20 prints and 20 dpi's but can be up to 40 of each.

### Rules for the Print Competition

- In round 1 we need at least 5 mono and 5 colour prints (the other 5 can be either colour or mono).
- There can be no more than 4 nature prints.
- In round 2 there has to be a minimum of 4 mono and 4 colour (the other 2 can be either).

What this means for us?• Everyone contributing prints should make an effort to contribute 1 mono print. This is not essential but will be helpful.
